LAY READERS! Please sign up in the DeRemer Gallery, especially as we need **seven readers** for our **Good Friday** service on **March 30**.

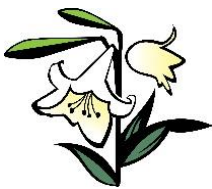
